DUE to adverse impact of COVID-19

The **Texas Workforce Commission (TWC)** Special Initiative provides up to \$10 million in Skills Development Fund grants for qualifying businesses and companies across the state of Texas.

Employers can request upskilling and re-training to counter the pandemic impact on their workforce and support recovery and rebuilding operations following the lifting of shelter-in-place orders. Special consideration will be given to new, essential or specialized high demand training for employers making products for COVID-19 safety, patient treatment, rehabilitation and the protection of healthcare workers.

Training provided at **NO COST** to qualifying employers.

Richland College will administer the grant and provide training at a value of up to \$2,000 per employee to responsive business partners. The TWC will fast track approved projects with training commencing within 30 days of grant approval.
